ELIGIBLE WORK

Any original work in any medium, completed in the last twelve months by any artist living, working, or studying in Porirua City.

ENTRIES

One work per artist may be submitted.

ACCEPTANCE OF WORKS

(a) No wet artworks or works that may emit offensive odours will be accepted.

(b) All work will be subject to selection by the Exhibition Selection Panel.

The decisions of both the selection panel & the judges are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

(c) Work selected for this award must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.

ARTIST'S STATEMENT

This is optional but is limited to a maximum of 100 words and can be submitted in a Word document to patakafriendsartawards@gmail.com by 26 August.

PRESENTATION

Entries must be presented in a manner that facilitates straightforward presentation with appropriate display or hanging devices. If a multi piece they must be ready to hang/display as one work or be attached together.

All works with an electrical component must be accompanied by a current Safety Certificate from a Master Electrician. Where we have concern as to safety, security, size or exhibition issues with a specific work this will be discussed with the artist and if the work needs to be withdrawn, the artist will be refunded their entry fee. Because of potential spatial constraints large installations may not be accepted.

Please attach swing tag and packaging label as requested.

COPYRIGHT/ IMAGES/INSURANCE

While we will endeavour to protect copyright, work is submitted at the artist's own risk. Any work received into the exhibition may be used for promotional purposes by the Friends of Pātaka.

Please note that Pātaka does not ensure items exhibited in the Bottle Creek Gallery. Exhibitors requiring insurance should make their own arrangements.
